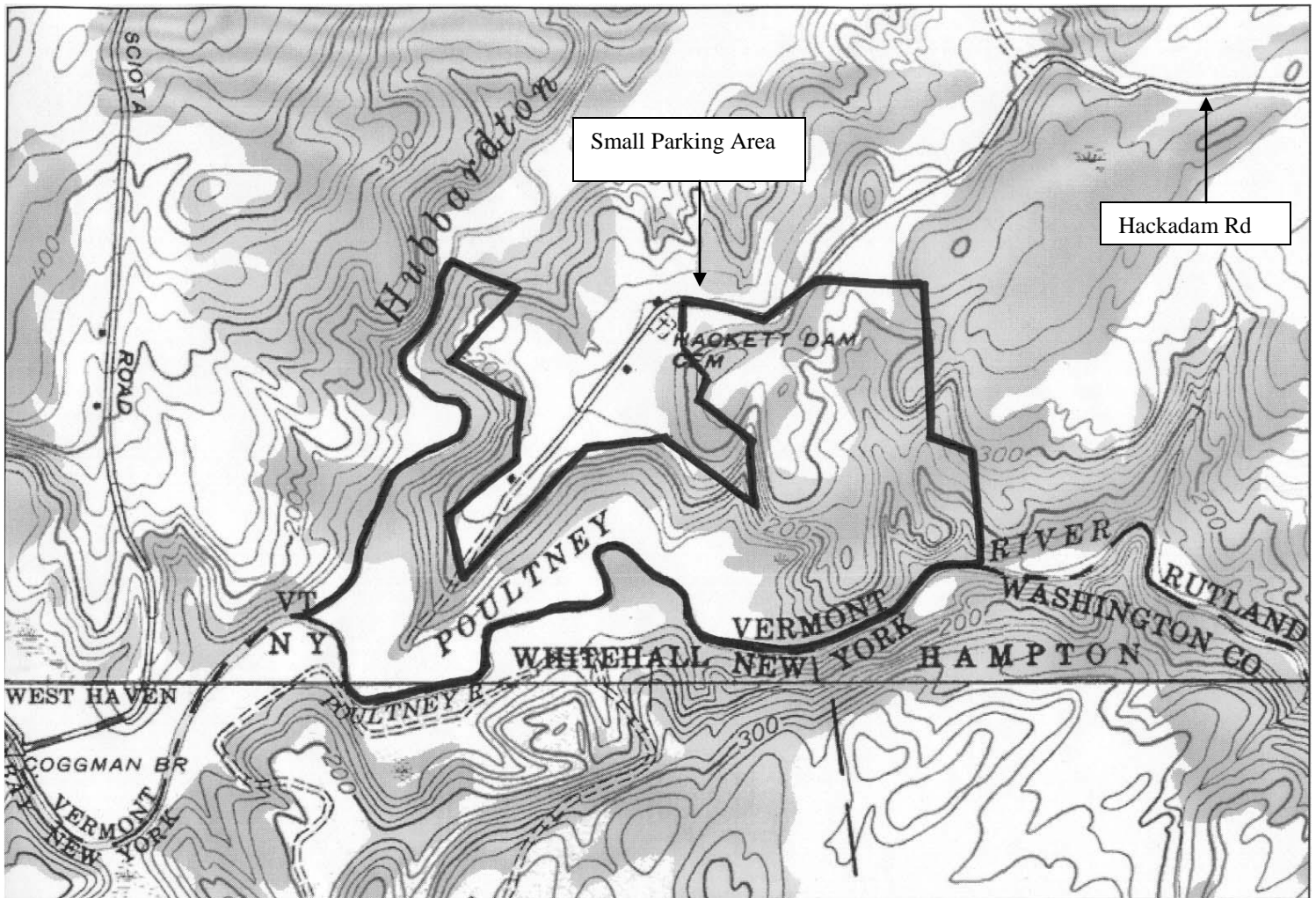


VT Lower Poultney River Preserve Map:



The Nature Conservancy's Lands Open for Fall Hunting from Oct 1st to Dec 31st on the Lower Poultney River Preserve in West Haven, Vermont

Directions: For Hackadam Road access, turn west from VT Route 22a (at 2.5 miles north of the junction with Route 4) onto Main Road in West Haven. Travel down Main Road for .7 miles and turn left onto Hackadam Road. Travel down the road for 1 mile, you will see our yellow boundary signs on the left where the preserve boundary borders the road for a bit. In 2005, we put in a small parking area for 2 cars. From here, you can hike onto the property, down ledges, and to the Poultney River. This tract of land is located just upstream of the confluence of the Hubbardton and Poultney Rivers. **There is no public access to the preserve from the end of Hackadam Rd**, this is private land and the fields are not part of the preserve.
